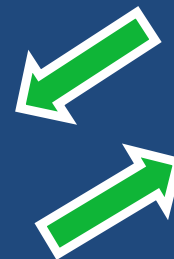
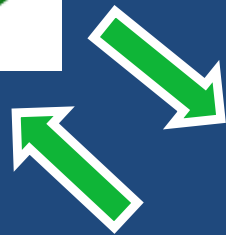

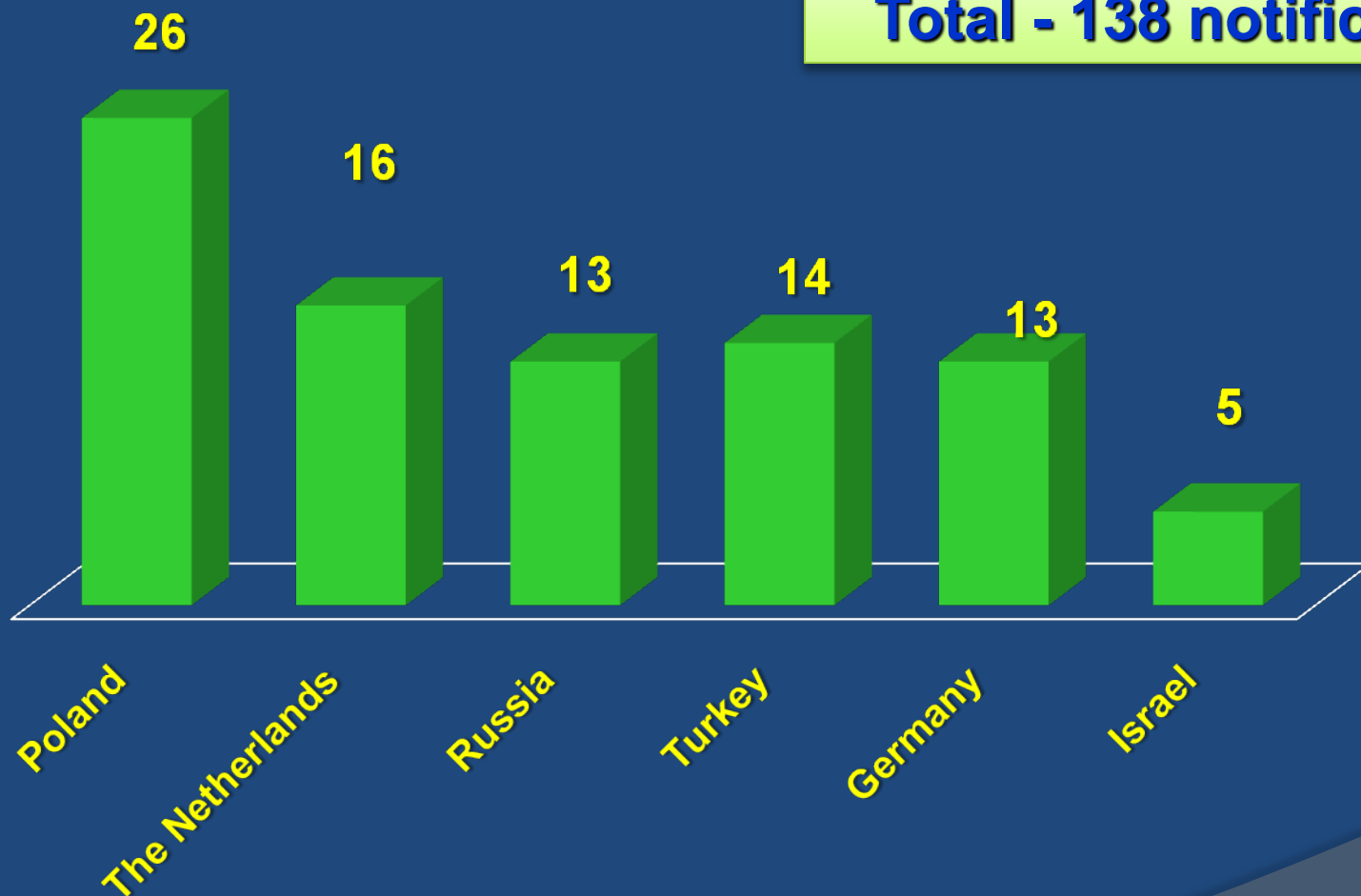
# Main task of phytosanitary inspectors at the state border is:

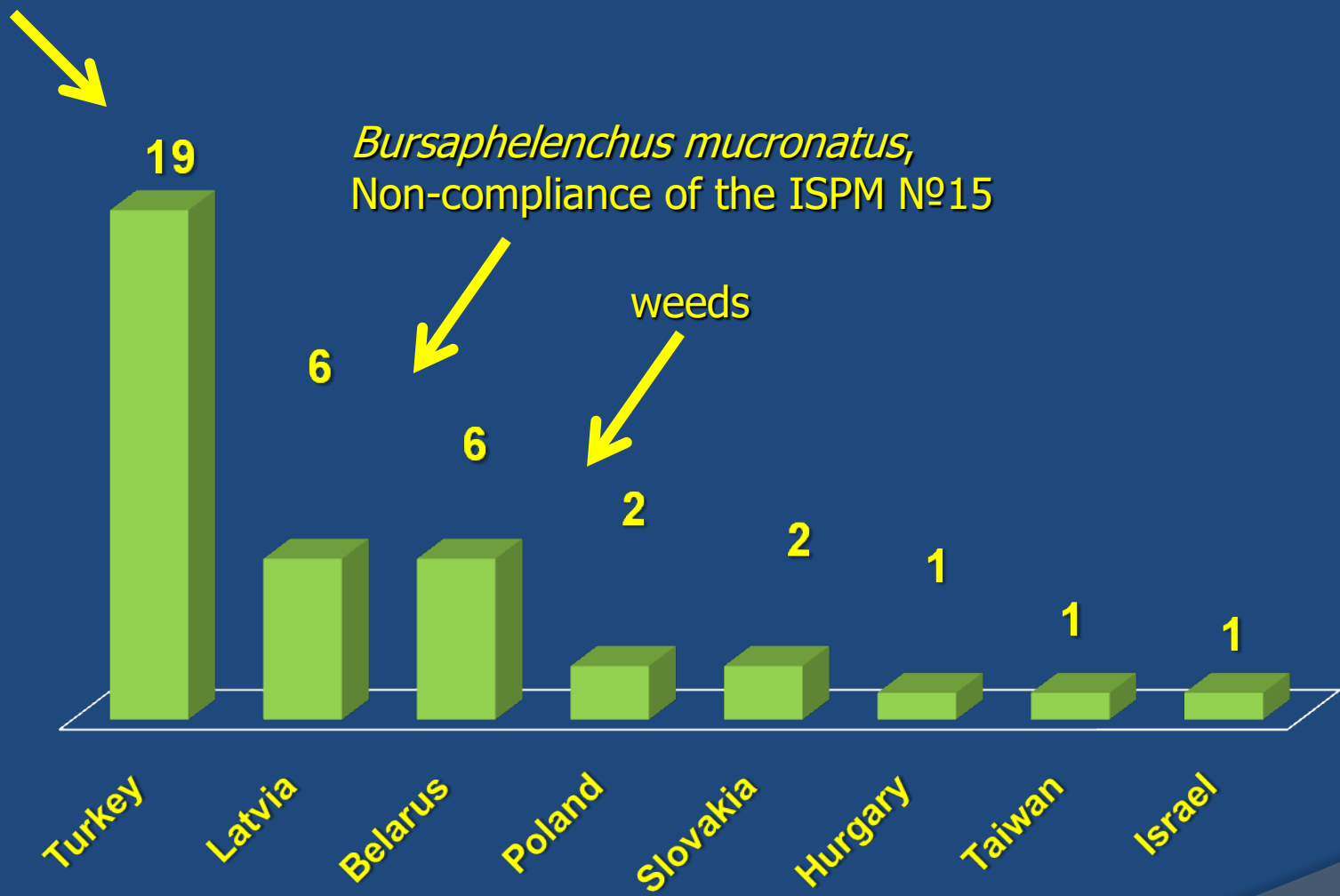
To prevent from entry *Phthorimaea operculella* Zell. and *Tuta absoluta* into the territory of Ukraine since December 1, 2010 import of potato, tomatoes, eggplants and pepper from the Republic of Turkey was prohibited



On January 24, 2011 due to inspection results of Solanaceous products in Turkey the abovementioned prohibition was removed



Holes more than 3 mm in timbers



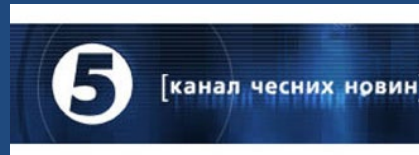

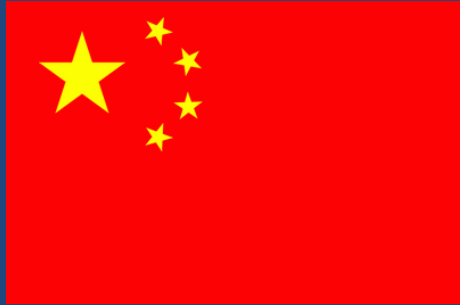
